Subject: Safeguarding Iran's National Infrastructure and Supporting the Transition to a National Government

**Dear Mr. President Trump,
Dear Prime Minister Netanyahu,**

At this decisive moment, which has engaged the attention of the free world, the Iranian Monarchy Party, as a patriotic political movement aligned with the voice of the Iranian nation, emphasizes the clear and necessary distinction between Iran's national assets and the instruments that sustain the current regime. Iran's infrastructure belongs to its people and constitutes a vital foundation for the reconstruction of a free Iran in the near future. By contrast, infrastructure controlled by the Islamic Republic forms part of a broader machinery of repression and destabilization that has been used to subjugate the Iranian people and undermine regional stability.

Declared Strategic Priorities:

1. Protection of National Infrastructure and Targeting the Apparatus of Repression





While reaffirming the necessity of ending the rule of the Islamic Republic, we respectfully call upon you to ensure that any strategic approach focuses on the regime's coercive and military capabilities, while safeguarding critical civilian infrastructure, including energy facilities, water systems, electricity networks, and transportation, which the Iranian people will urgently require during the transitional period and national reconstruction. Iran must be protected. The Islamic Republic must be dismantled.

2. A Call to Europe: Ending the Policy of Strategic Ambiguity

Addressing European nations currently facing significant energy challenges, we stress that the time for silence and short term expediency has passed. Firm support for the Iranian people's aspiration for change represents a sustainable path toward resolving Europe's long term energy concerns. In a free Iran, a responsible and nationally accountable government will emerge as a reliable and transparent partner for energy cooperation and major economic engagement, securing mutual interests within a stable and predictable framework.

3. Revocation of International Legitimacy and Recognition of a National Alternative

The international community should bring an end to the formal diplomatic recognition of the current regime within the United Nations and other multilateral institutions. The continuation of diplomatic relations and the operation of the regime's embassies in democratic countries effectively grants legitimacy to the repression of the Iranian people. We therefore call for the recognition of a national transitional government under the leadership of Prince Reza Pahlavi, an entity capable of managing the transition, preserving Iran's territorial integrity, and organizing free and fair elections.

4. Toward a New International Order

The realization of freedom in Iran is not only a national aspiration, but also a significant pillar in advancing a more stable international order. With the support of the United States and Israel, and above all through the sacrifice and determination of patriotic Iranians, the moment of Iran's liberation is approaching.
